Pittsboro Police Department Update

1. Citizen Police Academy- The academy will begin in April. We have 5 students in the first class.

2. N. Maple Speed Limit Change- Due to the road condition and narrow road width of North Maple Street, we are requesting that the speed limit be lowered to 20 MPH.

3. Brixton Yellow Line- The Pittsboro Fire Department and the police department are requesting that one side of Brixton Sub-Division be painted yellow for no parking. This is due to the large amount of vehicles in that addition that are left parked on the roadway. Fire engines are unable to get to certain addresses due to vehicles being parked on both sides of the roadway.

4. Operation Pullover- I have supplied the town board with information on operation pullover. The police department has been requested to participate in the last two blitzes of the year. I am requesting that the board approve our request to participate. This will provide additional police coverage to the town, and the officer's salary would be paid for through the grant. Officer's participating in operation pullover would still be required to take other complaints occurring in town.

5. Emergency Child Information Packet- Fingerprinting has been done at the Pittsboro Methodist Church Pre-School.

6. Employee Benefits Committee- All full time officers have advised they are interested in participating in the benefits committee.
