2005 Statistics

January-May 23rd the area averaged 1.2 tickets or warnings a month with an average speed of 18 mph over the speed limit.

May 23rd to July 12th the area averaged 2 tickets or warnings a month with an average speed of 17.25 over the speed limit

2006 Statistics

Pre May 23rd Town Board Meeting: That area averaged 5 tickets or warnings a month for 2006 with an average speed of 17 mph over the speed limit.

Post May 23rd Town Board Meeting: The area averaged 4 tickets or warnings a month with an average speed of 21.25 mph over the speed limit

One complaint of a near accident was received right after the stop signs were taken down.

To my knowledge, no back up during rush hours has been observed in the area. I did clock a motorist traveling eastbound onto Wall Street from the curve on Mitchell Ave. going 50 mph. I did get him stopped before he traveled through the intersection at that speed. Sgt. Stumm clocked another motorist in the curve going 48 mph.

We have not worked any accidents at the intersection since the stop signs came down.
